



### **School Safety & Security Reminders**

The school places great emphasis on school safety and security. We seek parents' cooperation in the following ways:

- If you need to meet your child's teacher, please make an appointment. Please enter only via Gate 2 and register at the Guard House. Do report to the General Office to meet the teacher/staff.
- Please put on the Visitor's Tag while on the school grounds and return this when you leave.
- Please do not make changes to your child's dismissal arrangements, unless there is a medical/family emergency.
- Parents who wish to pick their child up before dismissal time must report to the General Office to sign their child out.
- We are part of a larger Village. Please do not wander into the school blocks, whether the Primary or the other sectors or go into the canteen for a meal or drink.
- Students are to bring only the necessary stationery items to school. No scissors, penknives or any sharp objects are to be brought to school.

### **Traffic Safety**

• If you are driving to school in the morning, please ensure that your child alights promptly with his/her school bag when your vehicle comes to a halt at the drop-off zone in school. As there are other vehicles waiting behind yours, please drive off immediately after dropping your child off.

• Always maintain a safe speed of 10km/hr when driving within the school compound.


• As you are an important role model to your child, please observe road traffic rules at all times when driving:

Please comply with the "No Right Turn" restriction at the Sallim Road-Aljunied Road junction during the periods indicated on the sign ("7am-7.30am" and "1.30pm-2pm" on weekdays except public holidays). This helps to ease the traffic flow at peak times along Sallim Road for other road users.

> Avoid waiting in LTA's "No Waiting" zone along Sallim Road. Instead, plan to arrive 5 minutes or more after dismissal times, as your child will take time to make his/her way to the pick-up point in school.

Should you ride an e-bike (Power-Assisted Bicycle) to school with your child, please note that it is not allowed on footpaths such as those outside the school. E-bikes are only permitted on roads and shared paths like park connectors.

➢ Parking is not allowed in the school except for parents fetching students who are unwell or have special assistance needs. The nearest public carparks are located at the Circuit Road Hawker Centre, or the Lion City Sailors' Training Centre at Mattar Road.

## **Absence from School**

If your child is unable to attend school, please call the General Office at 6844 1418 from 7.00 am to 7.30 am.

Students must have a valid reason for absence from school. Absence from school for a long period of time will affect your child's progress in school.

If your child is absent for medical reasons, a medical certificate (MC) has to be produced and submitted to the Form Teacher when your child returns to school.

If your child is absent for valid reasons other than medical, a letter of explanation from the parent with documentary proof (where applicable, e.g. notice for piano examination, bereavement of family member, etc.) has to be submitted to the Form Teacher.

In addition, a Medical Certificate or a letter of explanation from parents must be submitted for all absences from Co-Curricular Activities and enrichment even if parents had earlier given consent for your child to attend the lessons.

Students must not be absent during term time to travel abroad without valid reasons. The school will have to be informed in writing and permission must be granted by the Principal prior to the purchase of travel tickets.

#### **Temperature-Taking Exercise**

All Primary 1 children will be given a thermometer in class. There is no need to make any purchase.


P2 - P6 children should start bringing their own oral digital thermometer on 6 January 2025 in preparation for the Temperature-Taking exercise on 15 January 2025.
